Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute to H.R. 7081 Offered by Mr. García of Illinois

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Ukraine Comprehen-3 sive Debt Payment Relief Act of 2022".

4 SEC. 2. SUSPENSION OF MULTILATERAL DEBT PAYMENTS 5 OF UKRAINE.

6 (a) UNITED STATES POSITION IN THE INTER-7 NATIONAL FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS.—The Secretary of the Treasury shall instruct the United States Executive 8 9 Director at each international financial institution (as defined in section 1701(c)(2) of the International Financial 10 11 Institutions Act) to use the voice, vote, and influence of 12 the United States to advocate that the respective institution immediately suspend all debt service payments owed 13 to the institution by Ukraine. 14

(b) OFFICIAL BILATERAL AND COMMERCIAL DEBT
16 SERVICE PAYMENT RELIEF.—The Secretary of the Treas17 ury, working in coordination with the Secretary of State,
18 shall commence immediate efforts with other governments

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and commercial creditor groups, through the Paris Club
 of Official Creditors and other bilateral and multilateral
 frameworks, both formal and informal, to pursue com prehensive debt payment relief for Ukraine.

5 FINANCIAL (c) Multilateral SUPPORT FOR UKRAINE.—The Secretary of the Treasury shall direct the 6 7 United States Executive Director at each international fi-8 nancial institution (as defined in section 1701(c)(2) of the 9 International Financial Institutions Act) to use the voice 10 and vote of the United States to support, to the maximum extent practicable, the provision of concessional financial 11 assistance for Ukraine. 12

13 (d) Multilateral Financial Support for Refu-GEES.—The Secretary of the Treasury shall direct the 14 15 United States Executive Director at each international financial institution (as defined in section 1701(c)(2) of the 16 International Financial Institutions Act) to use the voice 17 and vote of the United States to seek to provide economic 18 19 support for refugees from Ukraine, including refugees of African descent, and for countries receiving refugees from 2021 Ukraine.

22 SEC. 3. REPORT TO THE CONGRESS.

23 Not later than December 31 of each year, the Presi-24 dent shall—

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(1) submit to the Committees on Financial
 Services, on Appropriations, and on Foreign Affairs
 of the House of Representatives and the Committees
 on Foreign Relations and on Appropriations of the
 Senate, a report on the activities undertaken under
 this Act; and

7 (2) make public a copy of the report.

8 SEC. 4. WAIVER AND TERMINATION.

9 (a) WAIVER.—The President may waive the provi10 sions of this Act if the President determines that a waiver
11 is in the national interest of the United States and reports
12 to the Congress an explanation of the reasons therefor.
13 (b) TERMINATION.—The preceding provisions of this
14 Act shall have no force or effect on or after the date that
15 is 7 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
