 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Help Expedite Lagging
 - 5 Permitting for Defense Production Act" or the "Help
 - 6 DPA Act".

3	(b) Prioritized Permitting.—The Defense Pro-
4	duction Act of 1950 (50 U.S.C. 4501) is amended by in-
5	serting after section 711 the following:
6	"SEC. 712. PRIORITIZED PERMITTING.
7	"(a) In General.—With respect to a project that
8	is a covered national defense activity, if such project re-
9	quires a permit from a Federal agency, the Federal agency
10	shall prioritize the consideration of such permit over all
11	over projects requiring a permit from the agency.
12	"(b) Covered National Defense Activity De-
13	FINED.—The term 'covered national defense activity'
14	means a project—
15	"(1) funded in whole or in part with loans made
16	or guaranteed, or grants made, under title III;
17	"(2) in a sector essential for the national de-
18	fense with respect to which the President makes a
19	determination under this Act that the sector is expe-
20	riencing an industrial base shortfall; or
21	"(3) for the production of goods or services, the
22	contracts or orders for which the President has
23	deemed necessary or appropriate to promote the na-
24	tional defense and has prioritized under title I.".
