AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2868 OFFERED BY MR. AL GREEN OF TEXAS

At the end of the bill, add the following new section:

1	SEC. 5. MATCHING GRANTS FOR PRE-DISASTER MITIGA-
2	TION PROJECTS TO REDUCE NATIONAL
3	FLOOD INSURANCE PROGRAM CLAIMS AND
4	LOWER PREMIUMS FOR HOMEOWNERS.
5	(a) Authority.—The Administrator of the Federal
6	Emergency Management Agency may make grants under
7	this section to communities (as such term is defined in
8	section 1366(h) of the National Flood Insurance Act of
9	1968 (42 U.S.C. 4104c(h))) containing any area for which
10	a major disaster has been declared pursuant to the Robert
11	T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance
12	Act, in the amount necessary to reimburse communities
13	for excess non-Federal costs described in subsection (b)
14	of pre-disaster mitigation projects previously authorized
15	under Federal law and commenced within such commu-
16	nities.
17	(b) Grant Amount.—The non-Federal costs de-
18	scribed in this subsection are, with respect to a pre-dis-
19	aster mitigation project undertaken within a community,
20	the amount of non-Federal funds expended by such com-

- 1 munity, or to be expended by such community, to complete
- 2 the project in excess of the amount of such non-Federal
- 3 funds required, at the time of initiation of the project, to
- 4 be contributed toward completion of the project.
- 5 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
- 6 authorized to be appropriated such sums as may be nec-
