At the end of title V, add the following new section:

1	SEC. 511. CLARIFICATIONS; DEADLINE FOR APPROVAL OF
2	CLAIMS.
3	(a) Rules of Construction.—Part C of chapter
4	II of the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C.
5	4081 et seq.), as amended by the preceding provisions of
6	this Act, is further amended by adding at the end the fol-
7	lowing new section:
8	"SEC. 1350. RULES OF CONSTRUCTION.
9	"(a) Definition.—For purposes of this part, the
10	term 'knowingly' means having actual knowledge of or act-
11	ing with deliberate ignorance of or reckless disregard for
12	the prohibitions under this part.
13	"(b) Administrative Remedy.—A policyholder of a
14	policy for flood insurance coverage made available under
15	this title must exhaust all administrative remedies, includ-
16	ing submission of disputed claims to appeal under any ap-
17	peal process made available by the Administrator, prior
18	to commencing legal action on any disputed claim under
19	such a policy.".

(b) DEADLINE FOR APPROVAL OF CLAIMS.—

1	(1) In General.—Section 1312 of the Na-
2	tional Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C.
3	4019), as amended by the preceding provisions of
4	this Act, is further amended—
5	(A) in subsection (a), by striking "The Ad-
6	ministrator" and inserting "Subject to other
7	provisions of this section, the Administrator";
8	and
9	(B) by adding at the end the following new
10	subsection:
11	"(c) DEADLINE FOR APPROVAL OF CLAIMS.—
12	"(1) In General.—The Administrator shall
13	provide that, in the case of any claim for damage to
14	or loss of property under flood insurance coverage
15	made available under this title, an initial determina-
16	tion regarding approval of a claim for payment or
17	disapproval of the claim be made, and notification of
18	such determination be provided to the insured mak-
19	ing such claim, not later than the expiration of the
20	120-day period (as such period may be extended
21	pursuant to paragraph (2)) beginning upon the day
22	on which the policyholder submits a signed proof of
23	loss detailing the damage and amount of the loss.
24	Payment of approved claims shall be made as soon
25	as possible after such approval.

"(2) Extension of Deadline.—The Adminis-
trator shall provide that the period referred to in
paragraph (1) may be extended by a single addi-
tional period of 15 days in cases where extraordinary
circumstances are demonstrated. The Administrator
shall, by regulation, establish criteria for dem-
onstrating such extraordinary circumstances and for
determining to which claims such extraordinary cir-
cumstances apply.".
(2) Applicability.—The amendments made
by paragraph (1) shall apply to any claim under
flood insurance coverage made available under the
National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C.
4001 et seq.) pending on the date of the enactment
of this Act and any claims made after such date of



enactment.
