- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "No Ex-Im Assistance
- 5 for Terrorism Act".

3	Section 2(b) of the Export-Import Bank Act of 1945
4	(12 U.S.C. 635(b)) is amended by adding at the end the

6	"(14) Prohibition on Financing That Would

8	"(A) DIRECT FINANCING.—The Bank shall not
9	guarantee, insure, or extend (or participate in an ex-
10	tension of) credit in connection with any transaction
11	with respect to which credit assistance from the
12	Bank is first sought after the effective date of this
13	paragraph by—
14	"(i) the Government of Iran or an entity

"(ii) an entity created under Iranian law.
"(B) INDIRECT FINANCING.—The Bank shall
not guarantee, insure, or extend (or participate in an
extension of) credit in connection with any transaction with respect to which credit assistance from
the Bank is first sought after the effective date of
this paragraph involving—

26 entity referred to in subparagraph (A); or

"(ii) a non-United States entity that, in
the 5-year period ending with the date of the
enactment of this paragraph, has leased or reexported aircraft to the Government of Iran or
an entity referred to in subparagraph (A) in
contravention of United States law.

7 "(C) CANCELLATION OF APPROVED FINANC-8 ING.—The Bank shall cease the provision of finan-9 cial assistance approved by the Bank in connection 10 with a transaction with respect to which credit as-11 sistance from the Bank is first sought after the effective date of this paragraph, on finding that the 12 13 assistance has facilitated the export or re-export of 14 an aircraft to Iran, and shall seek immediate recov-15 ery of any amount provided by the Bank in connection with the transaction.". 16
