1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
This Act may be cited as the " Act

6 SEC. 2. ASSISTANCE FOR COLONIAS.
7 (a) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is

8 authorized to be appropriated for fiscal year 2023

9 \$700,000,000 for assistance to community development

1	block grant grantees, as determined by the Secretary of
2	Housing and Urban Development, under section 106 of
3	the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974
4	(42 U.S.C. 5306), only for colonia areas, to address the
5	community and housing infrastructure needs of existing
6	residents of colonia areas based on a formula that takes
7	into account persons in poverty in the colonia areas, except
8	that grantees may use funds in colonias outside of the
9	150-mile border area upon approval of the Secretary.
10	Amounts appropriated pursuant to this section shall re-
11	main available until September 30, 2033.
12	(b) Definition.—The term "colonia area" means
13	any census tract that—
14	(1) is an area of the United States within 150
15	miles of the contiguous border between the United
16	States and Mexico, except as otherwise determined
17	by the Secretary of Housing and Urban Develop-
18	ment; and
19	(2) lacks potable water supply, adequate sewage
20	systems, or decent, safe, sanitary housing, or other
21	objective criteria as approved by the Secretary.
22	(c) WAIVERS.—The Secretary may waive or specify
23	alternative requirements for any provision of title I of the
24	Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (42
25	U.S.C. 5301 et sea.) or regulation for the administration

- 2 other than requirements related to fair housing, non-
- 3 discrimination, labor standards, and the environment,
- 4 upon a finding that the waiver or alternative requirement
- 5 is necessary to expedite or facilitate the use of amounts
