1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

1	SEC. 2. TASK FORCE ON HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVEL-
2	OPMENT NEEDS IN AREAS OF PERSISTENT
3	POVERTY.
4	(a) Establishment; Duties.—There is established
5	a task force to—
6	(1) identify, examine, and analyze housing and
7	community development needs in areas of persistent
8	poverty in the United States, including in colonias
9	(as such term is defined in section 916 of the Cran-
10	ston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act (42
11	U.S.C. 5306 note), except that such term shall in-
12	clude colonias located outside of the 150-mile border
13	area), in the Southern Black Belt region, and in
14	Puerto Rico, the Mariana Islands, the Virgin Is-
15	lands, Guam, and American Samoa; and
16	(2) develop policy recommendations to address
17	such needs.
18	(b) Membership.—The task force shall consist of
19	the following members:
20	(1) The Secretary of Housing and Urban Devel-
21	opment or the Secretary 's designee, who shall serve
22	as a co-chairperson of the task force.
23	(2) The Secretary of Agriculture or the Sec-
24	retary's designee, who shall serve as a co-chair-
25	person of the task force

1	(3) The Director of the Federal Housing Fi-
2	nance Agency, or the Director's designee.
3	(4) The Director of the Bureau of Consumer
4	Financial Protection or the Director's designee.
5	(c) Consultation.—In carrying out its duties under
6	subsection (a), the task force shall consult with the Sec-
7	retary of Health and Human Services, the Secretary of
8	Education, the Secretary of the Interior, and the heads
9	of any other relevant agencies.
10	(d) Report.—Not later than the expiration of the
11	12-month period beginning on the date of the enactment
12	of this Act, the task force shall submit a report to the
13	Congress setting forth and analyzing the housing and
14	community development needs in areas of persistent pov-
15	erty identified pursuant to subsection (a) and rec-
16	ommendations to address such needs and shall make such
17	report publicly available online.
