- 2 (a) In General.—This Act may not be construed

- 5 with, the statutes, regulations, orders, or interpretations
- 6 in effect in any State, the District of Columbia, or any
- 7 territory of the United States, except to the extent that

- 11 (b) Greater Protection Under State Law.—
- 12 For purposes of this section, a statute, regulation, order,

- 15 sistent with the provisions of this Act if the protection that
- 16 such statute, regulation, order, or interpretation affords

- 1 to consumers is greater than the protection provided under

- 4 the District of Columbia, or any territory of the United
