- 11 (b) INCLUDED INFORMATION.—Each such annual re-
- 12 port shall include, with respect to the year preceding the
- 13 submittal of the report, a statement of the number of eligi-
- 14 ble individuals who were furnished such homelessness
- 15 services and the number of individuals furnished such
- 16 services under each such program, disaggregated by the
- 17 number of men who received such services and the number
- 18 of women who received such services, and such other infor-
- 19 mation as the Secretary considers appropriate.
