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A BILL

- To require the Director of the Federal Insurance Office to conduct a study regarding recruitment, retention, and attrition of employees in the insurance industry.

 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Diversify Insurers
 - 5 Workforce Study Act of 2022".

1	SEC. 2. STUDY AND REPORT ON RECRUITMENT, RETEN-
2	TION, AND ATTRITION.
3	(a) DEVELOPMENT.—The Director of the Federal In-
4	surance Office shall conduct a study to determine the
5	rates of and issues relating to recruitment, retention, and
6	attrition of employees of insurers, at all levels of employ-
7	ment and in all facets of the business of insurance.
8	(b) Report.—Not later than the expiration of the
9	6-month period beginning on the date of the enactment
10	of this Act, the Director shall submit to the Congress a
11	report describing the study conducted pursuant to sub-
12	section (a), setting forth the finding and conclusions of
13	the study, and recommending best practices for recruit-
14	ment and reducing attrition and improving retention and
15	promotion of employees.
16	(e) Definitions.—For purposes of this section, the
17	following definitions shall apply:
18	(1) Insurer.—The term "insurer" has the
19	meaning given such term in section 313(r) of title
20	31, United States Code.
21	(2) Business of Insurance.—The term
22	"business of insurance" has the meaning given such
23	term in section 1002 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street
24	Reform and Consumer Protection Act (12 U.S.C.
25	5481).
