2	Section 15E(i)(1)(B) of the Securities Exchange Act
3	of 1934 (15 U.S.C. 780–7(i)(1)(B)) is amended to read
4	as follows:
5	"(B) lowering or threatening to lower a
6	credit rating on, or refusing to rate, securities
7	or money market instruments issued by any
8	issuer or obligor, unless a portion of the securi-
9	ties or money market instruments owned by
10	such issuer or obligor, as applicable, also is
11	rated by such nationally recognized statistical
12	rating organization; or";
