A BILL

- To amend the Securities and Exchange Act of 1934 to amend the definition of whistleblower, to extend the antiretaliation protections provided to whistleblowers, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Whistleblower Protec-
 - 5 tion Reform Act of 2021".
