 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the ["____ Act of 2024"].

5 SEC. 2. DISGORGEMENT.

6 Section 21(d)(7) of the Securities Exchange Act of
7 1934 (15 U.S.C. 78u(d)(7)) is amended to read as follows:

1	"(7) DISGORGEMENT.—
2	"(A) IN GENERAL.—In any action or pro-
3	ceeding brought by the Commission against a
4	person for a violation of the securities laws, the
5	Commission may seek, and any Federal court
6	may order—
7	"(i) disgorgement of any unjust en-
8	richment received by the person from com-
9	mitting such violation; and
10	"(ii) that the disgorged funds be—
11	"(I) awarded to victims of such
12	violation; or
13	"(II) if it is not cost effective or
14	feasible to return funds to the victims
15	of such violation, deposited into the
16	Securities and Exchange Commission
17	Investor Protection Fund.
18	"(B) Unjust enrichment.—For pur-
19	poses of this paragraph, with respect to a per-
20	son that commits a violation of the securities
21	laws, unjust enrichment shall not include prof-
22	its from a violation that another person re-
23	ceived.
24	"(C) CALCULATION OF DISGORGEMENT
25	AMOUNT.—The amount of a disgorgement in

1 connection with a violation of the securities 2 laws described under subparagraph (A) shall be 3 the net profit of the person from committing such violation, which shall be calculated by tak-4 5 ing the profit received by the person from committing of such violation and deducting legiti-6 7 mate expenses (which shall not include expenses 8 incurred directly in the commission of the viola-9 tion). "(D) RULES APPLICABLE TO ALL
DISGORGEMENTS.—The requirements of this
paragraph shall apply to any disgorgement imposed by the Commission, whether directly or
through court order.".
