1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Advocating for Small  
5       Business Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. MAKING THE SEC EVEN MORE SMALL BUSINESS**  
2 **FRIENDLY.**

3 Section 4 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (15  
4 U.S.C. 78d) is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
5 lowing:

6 “(l) OFFICES OF SMALL BUSINESS.—The Commis-  
7 sion shall establish, within each division of the Commis-  
8 sion that performs rule writing activities, an Office of  
9 Small Business, which shall coordinate with the Office of  
10 the Advocate for Small Business Capital Formation on  
11 rules and policy priorities related to capital formation.”.
