6 "(1) OFFICES OF SMALL BUSINESS.—The Commis-7 sion shall establish, within each division of the Commis-8 sion that performs rule writing activities, an Office of 9 Small Business, which shall coordinate with the Office of 10 the Advocate for Small Business Capital Formation on 11 rules and policy priorities related to capital formation.".
