1SECTION 1. ACCURACY OF INFORMATION TRANSMITTED2BY RESELLERS.

3 Section 607 of the Fair Credit Reporting Act (15
4 U.S.C. 1681e) is amended by adding at the end the fol5 lowing:

6 "(f) Resellers.—

"(1) IN GENERAL.—Before a reseller transmits
information contained in a consumer report to an
end user or another reseller, such reseller shall follow reasonable procedures to assure maximum possible accuracy of the information concerning the individual about whom the information relates.

13 "(2) LIMITATION OF LIABILITY.—No reseller
14 may be held liable under this title if such reseller ac15 curately communicates information obtained from
16 another consumer reporting agency to an end user
17 or another reseller.

18 "(3) RESELLER DEFINED.—In this subsection
19 the term 'reseller' has the meaning given the term
20 in section 603.".
