A BILL

To modify sanctions with respect to the Government of Syria,
and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Syria Sanctions Ac-
5 countability Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. MODIFICATION OF SANCTIONS WITH RESPECT TO**
2 **THE GOVERNMENT OF SYRIA.**

3 The Caesar Syria Civilian Protection Act of 2019
4 (title LXXIV of division F of Public Law 116–92; 22
5 U.S.C. 8791 note) is amended—

6 (1) in section 7431(a)—

7 (A) in the matter preceding paragraph (1),
8 by striking “for renewable periods of not more
9 than 180 days”; and

10 (B) by adding after paragraph (7) the fol-
11 lowing:

12 “(8) The Government of Syria is taking mean-
13 ingful steps to combat the illicit production and
14 international illicit proliferation of Captagon.”;

15 (2) in section 7432—

16 (A) in subsection (b)—

17 (i) in paragraph (1), by striking “, for
18 renewable periods not to exceed 180
19 days,”; and

20 (ii) in paragraph (2), by striking “and
21 every 180 days thereafter while the waiver
22 remains in effect,”; and

23 (B) in subsection (c)—

24 (i) in paragraph (1), by striking “, for
25 renewable periods not to exceed 2 years,”;
26 and

1 (ii) in paragraph (2), by striking “and
2 every 180 days thereafter while the waiver
3 remains in effect,”; and

4 (3) in section 7438 to read as follows:

5 **“SEC. 7438. SUNSET.**

6 “This title shall cease to be effective on the earlier
7 of—

8 “(1) the date that is 30 days after the date that
9 the President reports to Congress that the Govern-
10 ment of Syria has met the criteria described in para-
11 graphs (1) through (8) of section 7431(a) for 2 con-
12 secutive years; or

13 “(2) December 31, 2029.”.

14 **SEC. 3. ACTIONS AT THE INTERNATIONAL MONETARY**
15 **FUND AND THE WORLD BANK.**

16 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Treasury
17 shall instruct the United States Executive Directors at the
18 International Monetary Fund and the International Bank
19 for Reconstruction and Development to use the voice and
20 vote of the United States to support the following;

21 (1) The restoration of sound data reporting and
22 regular economic monitoring in Syria.

23 (2) Technical assistance to strengthen anti-
24 money laundering measures taken by the Govern-
25 ment of Syria.

1 (3) A strategy to address humanitarian needs
2 in the civilian population of Syria.

3 (b) CONGRESSIONAL BRIEFINGS.—Within 180 days
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act, and 1 year
5 thereafter, the Secretary of the Treasury shall provide a
6 briefing to the Committee on Financial Services of the
7 House of Representatives and the Committee on Foreign
8 Relations of the Senate on the activities described in sub-
9 section (a).

10 (c) SUNSET.—The preceding provisions of this sec-
11 tion shall have no force or effect beginning on the date
12 that is 2 years after the date of the enactment of this
13 Act.
