3	SECTION 1. OCC STUDY ON BANK-FINTECH PARTNERSHIPS.
4	(a) Study.—The Comptroller of the Currency shall
5	carry out a study of—
6	(1) how bank-fintech partnerships can support
7	new bank formation, including how these partner-

ships reduce time to market for bank products and

1	services, lower compliance burdens, boost customer
2	acquisition, improve technological capabilities, and
3	provide access to more diverse funding sources; and
4	(2) what regulatory and legal uncertainties are
5	hindering these partnerships.
6	(b) Report.—Not later than 6 months after the date
7	of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller of the Currency
8	shall issue a report to Congress containing all findings and
9	determinations made in carrying out the study required
10	under subsection (a).
