## A BILL

- To provide for greater transparency in the HUD-VASH supported housing program for homeless veterans, and for other purposes.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
  - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
  - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Homes for Our Heroes
  - 5 Act of 2019".
  - 6 SEC. 2. CONGRESSIONAL FINDINGS.
  - 7 The Congress finds the following:

| 11 | and more than 160,000 homeless veterans have been    |
| 12 | provided with vouchers.                              |
| 13 | (4) The number of veterans experiencing home-        |
| 14 | lessness has declined by over 30,000 since 2009, ac- |
| 15 | cording to data from the annual Point-in-Time        |
| 16 | Homeless Count organized by HUD.                     |
| 17 | (5) Under the HUD–VASH program, veterans             |
| 18 | benefit from affordable housing and matching sup-    |
| 19 | portive services, such as mental health treatment,   |
| 20 | substance use counseling, and employment training.   |
| 21 | (6) In the past year, some regions of the Nation     |
| 22 | have seen an increase in the numbers of veterans ex- |
| 23 | periencing homelessness, particularly in high-cost   |
| 24 | housing markets where housing is becoming less af-   |
