1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4 This Act may be cited as the "Expanding Housing
5 Opportunities for Foster Youth Act of 2018".
6 SEC. 2. CONGRESSIONAL FINDINGS.
7 The Congress finds that—

(1) approximately 21,000 foster youth age out

of foster care each year according to the Administra-

1	tion for Children and Families (ACF) of the Depart-
2	ment of Health and Human Services;
3	(2) more than 1 out of every 4 foster youth who
4	age out of foster care will experience homelessness
5	by age 21, according to survey data from the Na-
6	tional Youth in Transition Database compiled by the
7	ACF;
8	(3) access to safe, decent, and affordable hous-
9	ing is essential to helping foster youth successfully
10	transition to adulthood;
11	(4) foster youth deserve a place to call home
12	without being singled out for harmful requirements
13	like work requirements as a condition of receiving
14	housing assistance;
15	(5) the Family Unification Vouchers program
16	of the Department of Housing and Urban Develop-
17	ment provides housing assistance for foster youth
18	along with case management, without work require-
19	ments; and
20	(6) there is insufficient funding for Family Uni-
21	fication Vouchers to serve all foster youth in need.

1	SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF FUNDING FOR FAMILY UNIFI-
2	CATION VOUCHERS PROGRAM.
3	Paragraph (1) of section 8(x) of the United States
4	Housing Act of 1937 (42 U.S.C. 1437f(x)(1)) is amended
5	to read as follows:
6	"(1) Increase in Budget authority.—The
7	budget authority available under section 5(c) for
8	voucher assistance under section 8(o) is authorized
9	to be increased by \$200,000,000 on or after October
10	1, 2018, and any such sums made available shall re-
11	main available until expended.".
