

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
OFFERED BY MR. GOODEN OF TEXAS
[Budget Reconciliation]**

Page 15, line 12, strike “and”.

Page 15, line 16, strike the period and insert “;
and”.

Page 15, after line 16 insert the following:

1 (D) no individual within the household
2 earned income exceeding \$75,000 in calendar
3 year 2020 or, at any point after an application
4 for assistance under this section, earns a
5 monthly income which exceeds one-twelfth of
6 \$75,000.

Page 16, after line 11, insert the following:

7 (1) INCOME LIMITATION.—Paragraph (3) of section
8 501(k) of subtitle A of title V of division N of the Consoli-
9 dated Appropriations Act, 2021 (Public Law 116–260) is
10 amended by inserting at the end the following:

11 “(D) INCOME LIMITATION.—No assistance
12 under this section shall be provided or renewed

1 to any eligible household in which an individual
2 within the household earned income exceeding
3 \$75,000 in calendar year 2020 or, at any point
4 after an application for assistance under this
5 section, earns a monthly income which exceeds
6 one-twelfth of \$75,000.”.

Page 20, after line 2, insert the following:

7 (7) INCOME LIMITATION.—Except in the case of
8 qualifying individuals under subsection (b)(2)(C), no
9 assistance under this section shall be provided or re-
10 newed to a qualifying individual or family for which
11 the qualifying individual or any individual within a
12 qualifying family earns an annual income exceeding
13 \$75,000.

Page 32, after line 25, insert the following:

14 (e) INCOME LIMITATION.—Except in the case of
15 qualifying individuals under subsection (b)(3), no assist-
16 ance under this section shall be provided or renewed to
17 a qualifying individual or family for which the qualifying
18 individual or any individual within a qualifying family
19 earns an annual income exceeding \$75,000.

Page 37, after line 19, insert the following:

1 (3) INCOME LIMITATION.—No assistance under
2 this section shall be provided to assist a homeowner
3 in a household in which any individual within that
4 household earns an annual income exceeding
5 \$75,000.
